

The RN to BSN Completion program — developed by Mercy College PLUS and powered by OpusVi — is for licensed registered nurses (RNs) with an Associates of Arts (AA) degree, Associate of Science in Nursing (ASN) degree, or a bachelor's degree other than a BSN to obtain a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN).
